

Wintergreen Music began in 1995 at a meeting of mountain and valley property owners at Wintergreen Resort with a shared love for music. The group organized and held concerts in homes and various facilities throughout the community.

In 1997, the organization received its 501(c)(3) status and launched the first Wintergreen Music Festival. Wintergreen Music continued to grow in scale and today, it presents a full month of outstanding, memorable, and surprising musical offerings from the Mountaintop and throughout Nelson County.

Wintergreen Music Festival (WMF) takes place every July for four weeks with "music to match the views." The Wintergreen Festival Orchestra is comprised of Wintergreen Festival Artists, who come from top orchestras, chamber music societies, and faculty rosters around the country. These talented musicians perform music from many genres, including classical, jazz, Motown, bluegrass, and more.
